

Meeting diverse housing needs – Gypsies and Travellers

New and existing homes should meet Londoners' diverse housing needs.

The Mayor will:

- expect councils to actively plan for the accommodation requirements of London's Gypsies and Travellers. This should include the development of permanent sites, as well as improvements to and protections for existing capacity. The Mayor's planning policies to support this will be included in his draft London Plan
- work with the Gypsy and Traveller community and councils:
 - to ensure that the housing needs of Gypsies and Travellers are met
 - to provide funding for new sites and improvements for existing sites through his £3.15bn Homes for Londoners Affordable Homes Programme.
