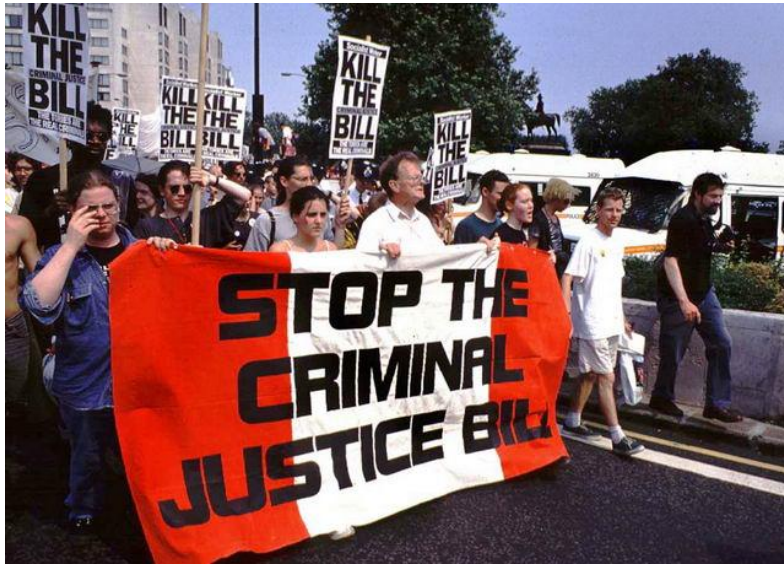

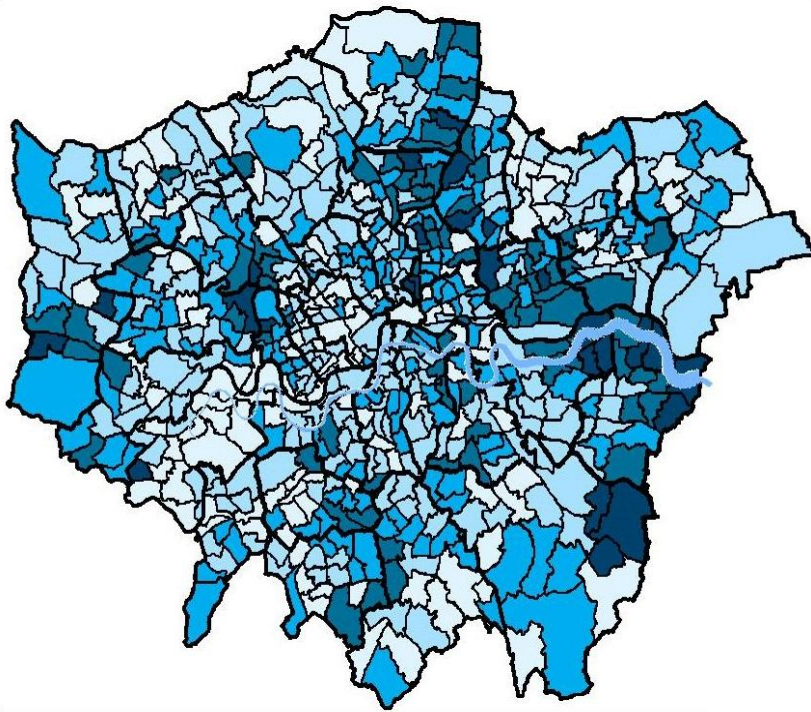

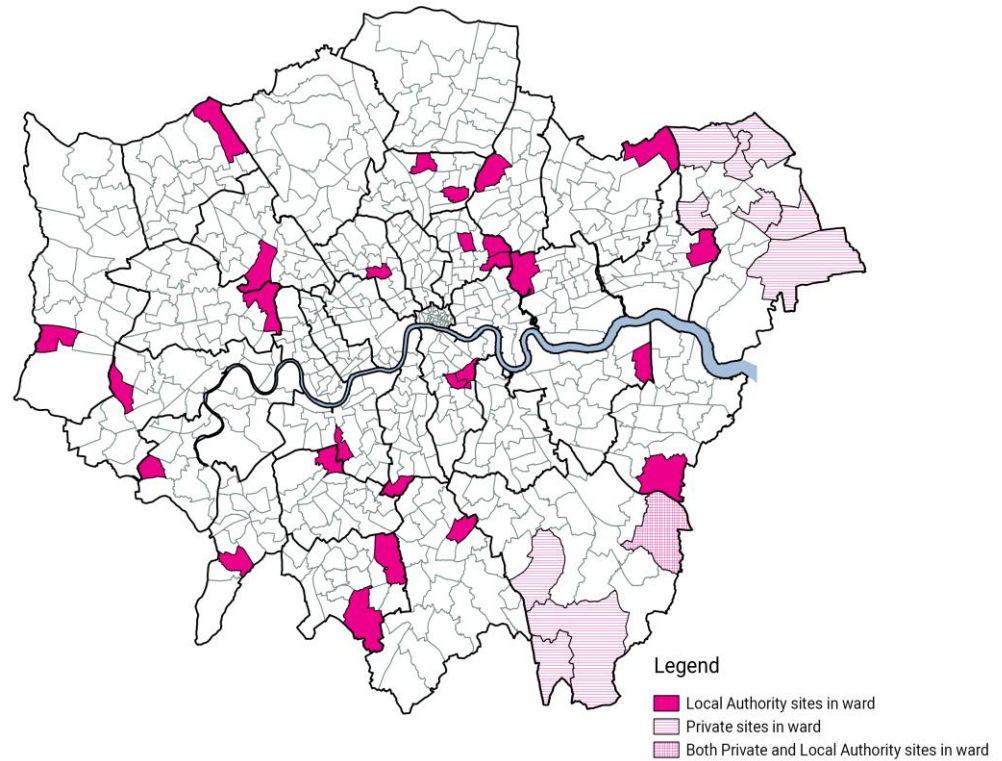


# Insufficient accommodation

Gypsy and Traveller population by ward

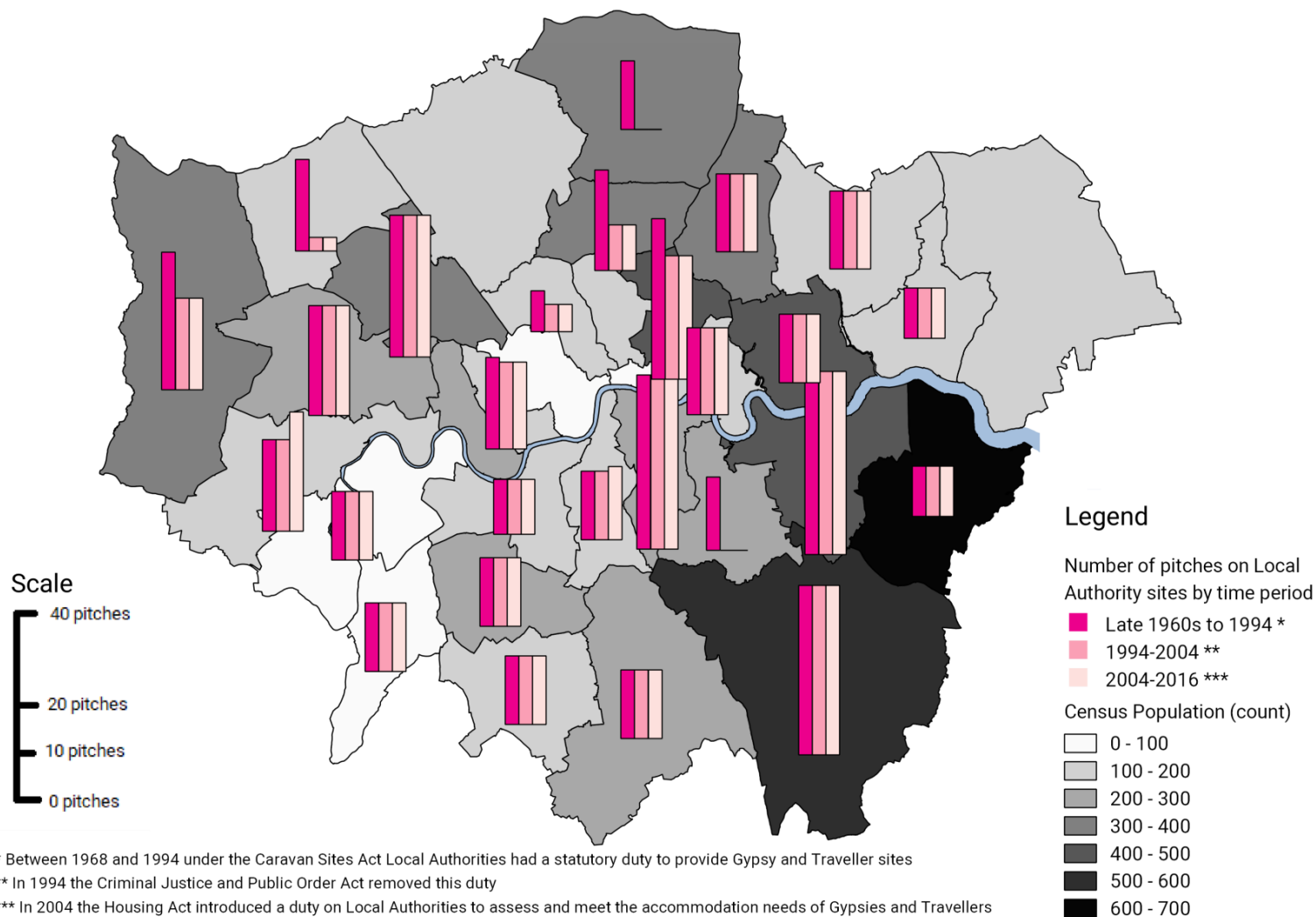


Gypsy and Traveller sites in London at ward level



# Loss of council sites

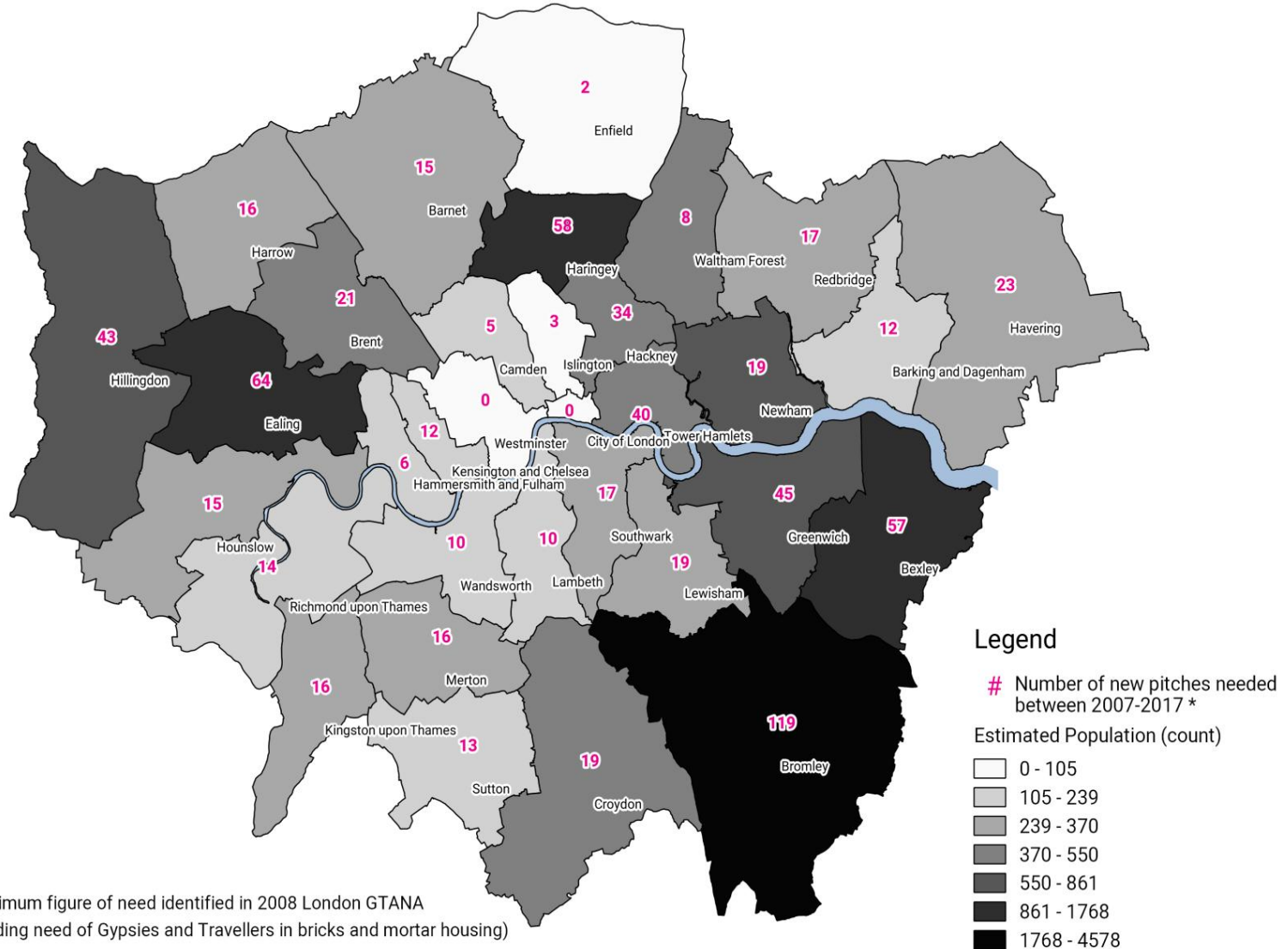
Number of pitches on Local Authority sites and Gypsy and Irish Traveller population (2011)





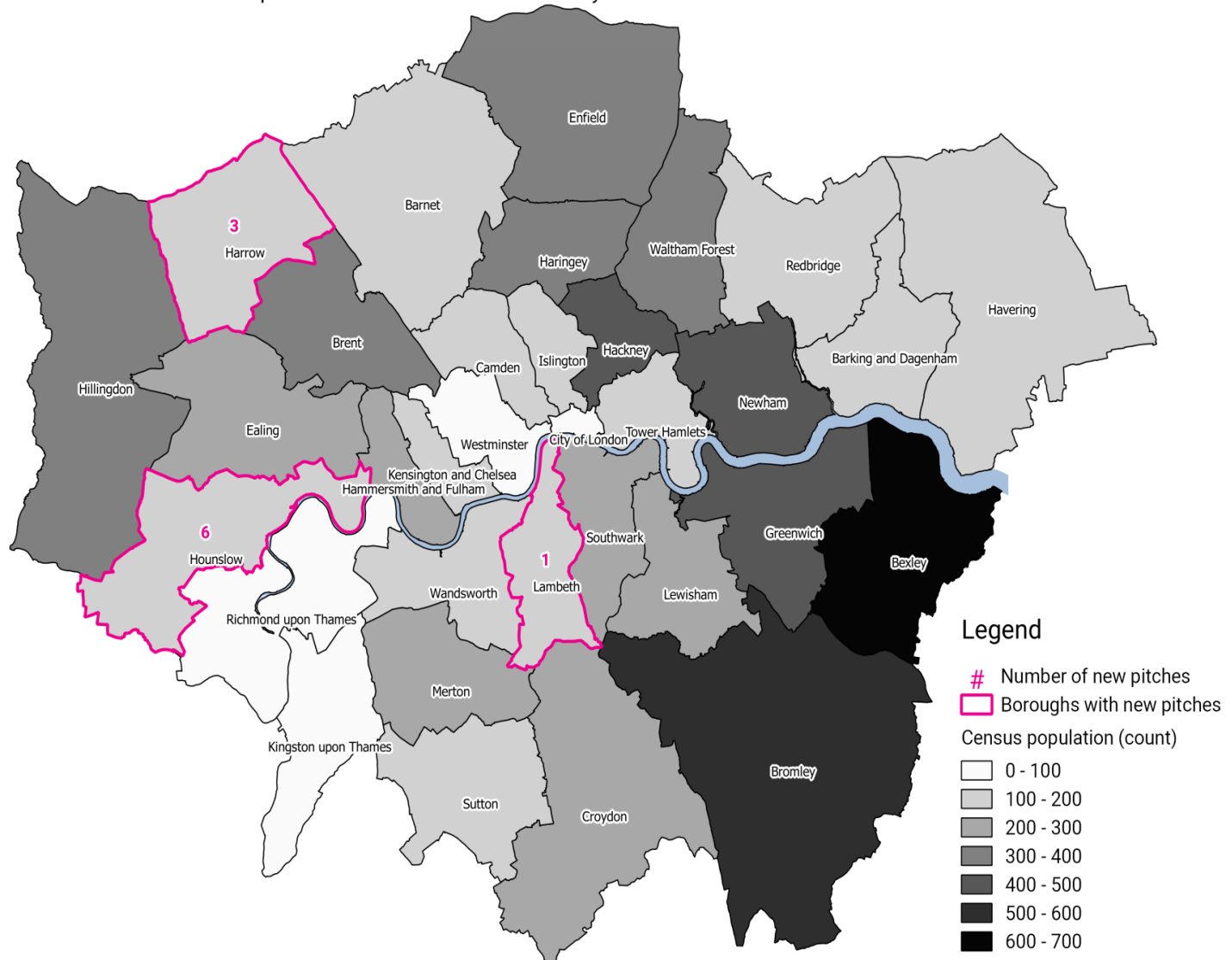

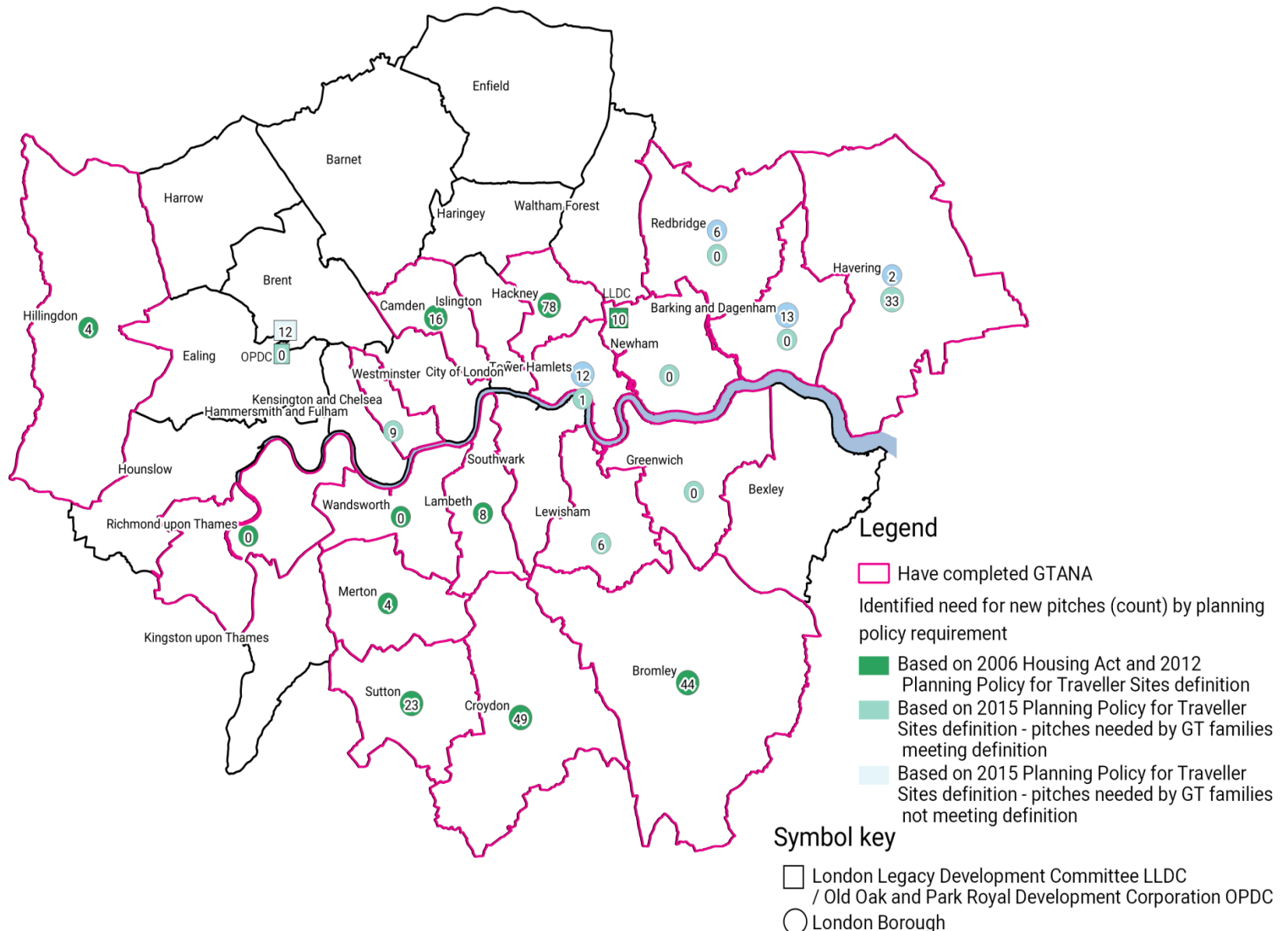
New pitches delivered on Local Authority sites since the 2008 London GTANA

# What the housing crisis means for Gypsies and Travellers in London



- More families pushed in unsuitable housing
- Temporary and emergency accommodation
- Discrimination and frequent evictions in the private rented sector

- Rise in unauthorised encampments
- Huge social costs: family and community life, health, education, work
- Challenge of density/viability vs social value and equality duty
